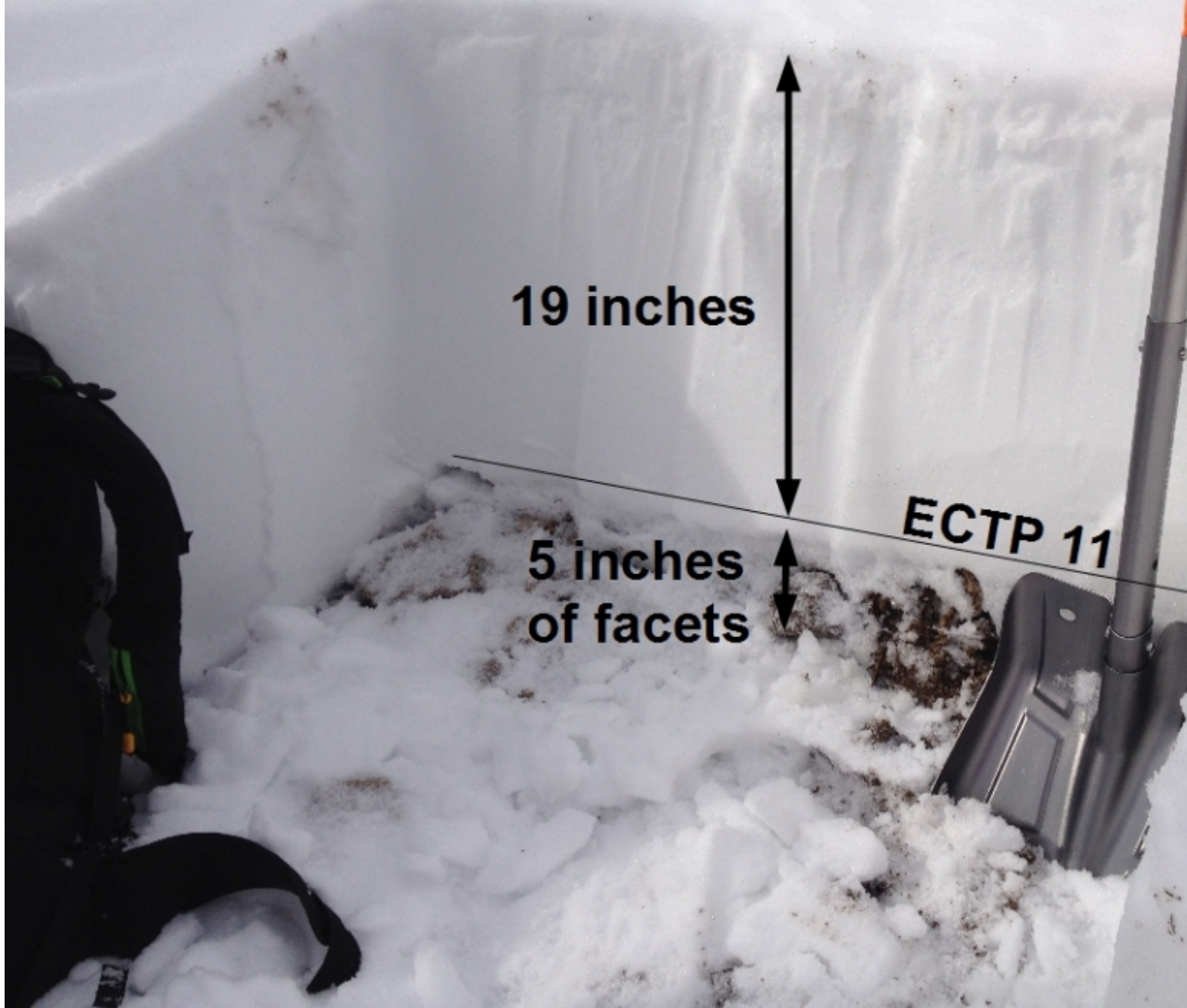


SE aspect
