

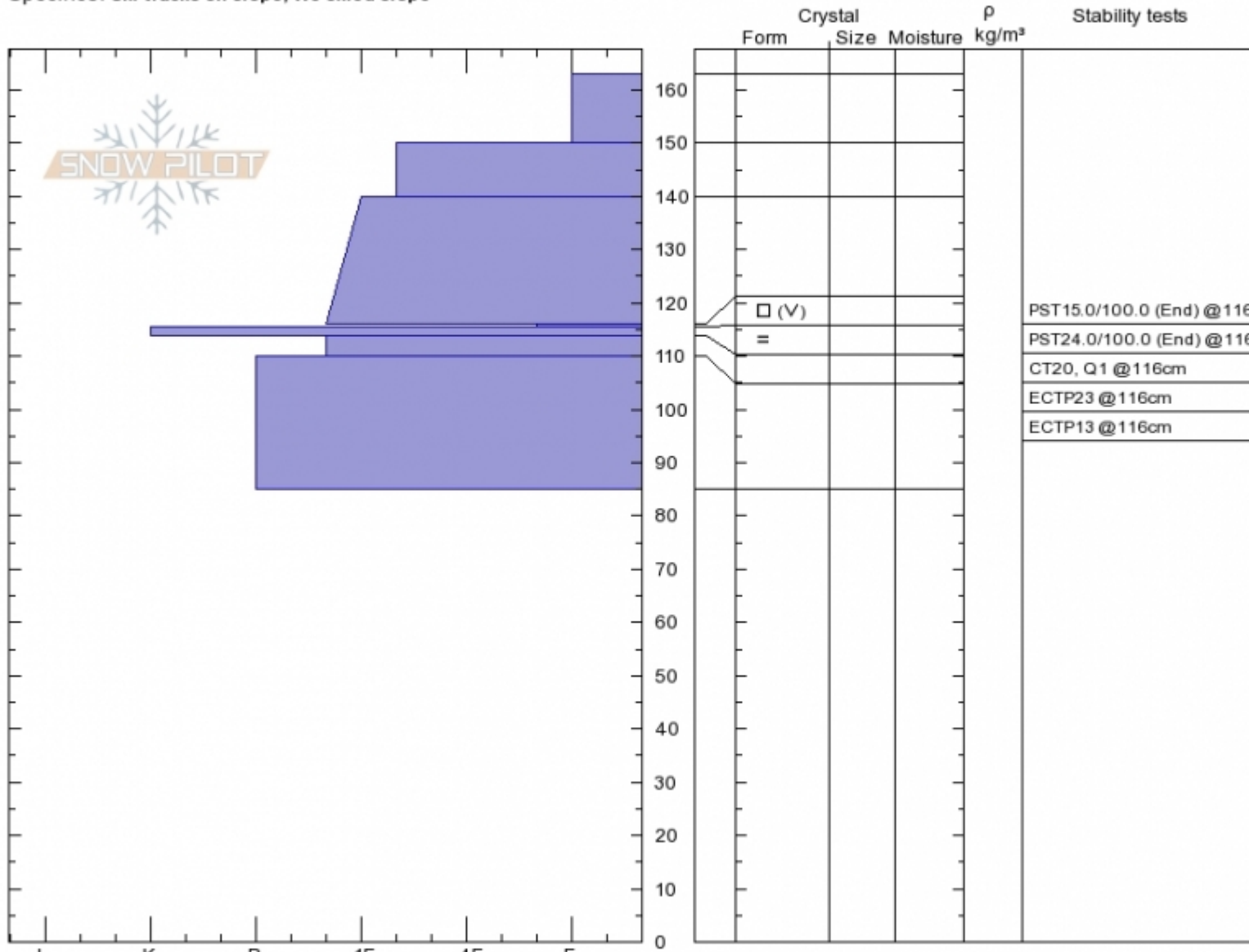

V was obvious until CT, and then ECTP 13 was a bit of a surprise. Shorter PST cut (15/100) was result of placing slab from previous test PST, essentially doubling the load.
